



Fr. Bernard Henry Kintrup

Fr. Bernard H. Kintrup was born in Cincinnati, OH, in 1841. Bernard was ordained in Vincennes: Tonsure and Minor Orders were received on May 25, 1866. He became a sub-Deacon on June 17; a Deacon on June 18, and a Priest on June 21, 1867. His first charge was in Troy, IN, with Rockport as a mission from 1867 until November 14, 1869.

Fr. Kintrup received orders to go to Mitchell. The Bishop changed the order and Fr. Kintrup went to Bradford instead until November 23, 1870. Then Fr. Kintrup spent time in Mitchell until August 1871. From there he was sent to Salem, with Shoals as a mission until June 4, 1873. He then went on to St. James (Hyden) and Napoleon until March 1878.

Fr. Kintrup was in Princeton, IN, at St. Joseph Catholic Church from March 3, 1878 to November 3, 1878. He was then sent to St. Henry.

Fr. Kintrup undertook his last assignment in Montezuma around Christmas of 1879. Circumstances indicate that early in the morning of May 30, 1882, he crossed the Wabash on the railroad bridge at Montezuma and was overtaken by a train. He tried to save himself and fell into the river and drown. His coat and breviary were found on the bridge. His body was found and buried from the Montezuma Church, Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Arniesburg on Raccoon Creek, a few miles south of Montezuma where his grave is marked with a headstone.
