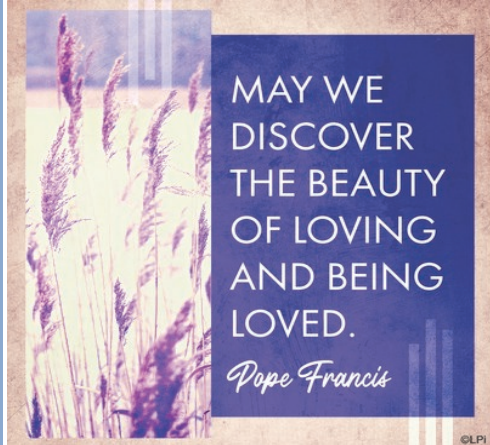

HS Fingers & Toes Event. High school youth are invited to come be the Body of Christ (hands, feet, fingers, toes, etc!) On Sat. Then, we'll go to United Caring shelter to prepare and serve a meal and handout care packages. Afterward, we'll have some fun bowling at Franklin Lanes and come back to close with 4:30 Mass at HC, and a spaghetti dinner in the cafeteria. **Cost is \$10. Summer Conferences – Notre Dame Vision, One Bread One Cup, MDI @ Marian. Notre Dame Vision, St. Meinrad's One Bread, One Cup, and Marian's MDI are great 5-day summer conferences that we offer to high school youth. They are slightly different in nature. Notre Dame Vision is a leadership conference that helps develop the faith and gifts of high school youth to imitate the lives of Jesus Christ and the Saints in our current culture. One Bread, One Cup focuses more on developing the youth's gifts to serve in the liturgy at Mass like being a Eucharistic minister, cantor, lector, etc. MDI is a smaller, more immersive experience that prepares high school students to be young missionaries who serve their communities and impact the world through the local church. For now, we just need to know who's interested in one of these conferences. We will try to keep cost of each affordable thru fundraising and scholarships, but with increased demand over the past couple years we first need to know how many are interested. **Please contact Bryan ASAP if interested (deadlines are slightly different for the 3 but all coming up in early March)**

Summer Mission Trip to Appalachia, KY for HS Youth. Share your time, talent and open your heart to people in need. This year we will return to St. Vincent Mission in David, KY in the heart of Appalachia. Types of work have included demolition, drywall, painting, building wheel chair ramps, yard work, replacing floors & porches. The dates for the mission are **July 12-17. We need a few skilled adult chaperones. Turn in a \$25 deposit to reserve your spot.** Cost for each youth is \$100 for the trip. We will have a fundraiser to help with deferring the cost (actual cost per person about \$300). Trip will include a day of mountain fun on the way home!

DIOCESAN POLICY: REPORT AND INFORM

The Diocese of Evansville has in place a policy that requires that any allegation of child abuse must be reported to civil authorities. If an allegation involves the sexual abuse of a minor by diocesan personnel, the Victim Assistance Coordinator must also be informed.

Sexual Misconduct violates human dignity and the mission of the church.

Every allegation of child abuse must be reported to Child Protection Services, an agency of Indiana state government.

WELCOME RETREAT—Formally CHRIST RENEWS HIS PARISH

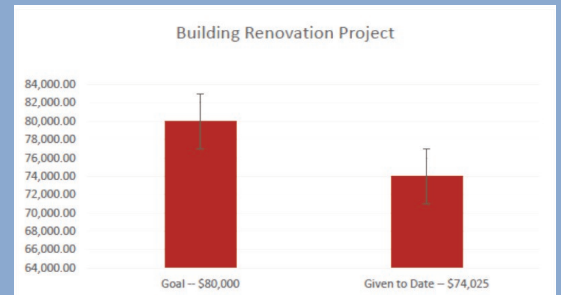
