

For many years, the Diocese of Evansville has benefited from the ministry of those formed at Saint Meinrad Archabbey, Seminary and School of Theology. Next weekend our parish will learn more about their important work from a monk of Saint Meinrad. Father Simon Herrmann, OSB, Director of Young Adult Evangelization in our Development Office will be coming to Celebrate Mass with us at both parishes.

In our diocese, 47 active and retired priests, 49 permanent deacons, and 335 lay ministers attended Saint Meinrad. In addition, countless high school students were formed in faith and prepared for liturgical ministry through Saint Meinrad's "One Bread, One Cup" program.
