

from the pastor*

Dear Parishioners,

As we begin this new journey as I serve as your Pastor, I wanted to share a little about me. My Parents are George and the late Rose Mary Kaiser. My sisters are Diana Graman and Jenny Staley. We lived on a family farm south of Vincennes. I went to Flaget and Rivet Catholic Schools and then attended V.U. I graduated from USI with a degree in Communications, and then began working for the Knox County Chamber of Commerce. When my position was eliminated, I accepted a position managing a Toys R Us store in Louisville. Then I worked for a Financial Advising firm in Carmel working with high net worth clients. That position played a part into my discernment of Priesthood. I soon realized money would not make one happy, often it caused more challenges. During that time, I was involved with two Young Adult groups and began to go to daily Mass.

I met Fr. Bernie at St. Joe and began the process of studying for the Priesthood. I went to Saint Meinrad, graduated and was ordained in 2006 by Bishop Gerald. Some of you I have served before, some I have met through the years. All of you will be in my prayers and I promise to walk with you in this journey of faith and life.

Most of you want to know about Benedict. He is a mini-Golden doodle. In July he turns 2. He is trained as a Service Dog and I often bring him to school, and he assists with my ministry. He helps calm people when they are stressed, and he simply loves all people. We both enjoy going for walks. Collecting and refinishing antiques is a hobby of mine. I enjoy movies, going out to eat or eating in with family and friends. I love the Eucharist, have a devotion to Mary and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. I enjoy the opportunity to meet all of you.
