


**Diocesan Listening Session Survey**

## Lent-The Cross

In 2017, I was faced with dealing with long term and extreme anxiety. I took time off from ministry to develop life skills to assist me in dealing with situations in my life, some of which I had no influence over, others which I intentionally or unintentionally created.

All people can relate to the fact that some situations, which we have no influence on, are left only to our response of how we react. Those situations can become crosses in our life. Other influencers come from when we drift off in the day to day struggles and make poor choices. We become distracted by the noise of life. Examples include poor nutrition, exercise habits, sleeping habits and a dryness in our spiritual life; and like all humans, we fall into temptation.

In the dark of the storm and the low points of anxiety or depression, I am comforted by an image that most people in our world view and see it as barbaric, or simply ignore it. Viewing the Crucifix helps me to visualize the pain and suffering that Jesus endured for all of humanity. As I gaze, I see that he was bruised, humiliated, tortured, abandoned, and left for dead. He understands pain, he understands my pain.

I am comforted through God's infinite love; Jesus became human, lifting us all up. In my own humanity, I am consoled that Christ understands the difficulty of temptation. I am encouraged by His life, ministry, passion, death and most significantly Christ's resurrection. Christ taught us what matters most is the love we share with God and one another. I firmly believe from His Cross, came Christ's most powerful prayer; "Forgive them, they know not what they do."

Placing myself before God and reflecting upon the Crucifix, I understand that dealing with my anxiety and depression are also gifts. Through this journey over the past three years, the experiences have enabled me to minister to those dealing with anxiety and depression with an empathy and greater understanding of what others are experiencing. The Crucifix reminds me to be patient in the crosses of my life and to be patient when I walk with others who are working through their own struggles.

The difference between vulnerability and weakness is that vulnerability takes both strength and courage. I invite and encourage you, if you are facing anxiety/depression or any other cross in your life; know that you are not alone and that you are loved. If you are not facing either anxiety or depression, odds are that you know someone who is. Love your neighbor by listening and being present in their cross. Ask questions, see if they need anything. Be a voice that calls them out of their darkness into the light of Christ.
