

Now that the Lenten season has begun it is a good time to reflect on how we integrate our faith into our lives and what we do during this time. Lent lasts for 40 days beginning on Ash Wednesday and concludes at sundown on Holy Thursday. Easter is celebrated on the first Sunday after the first full moon following the Spring equinox.

The school children often ask why the priests and deacons wear a particular color of vestments. The Liturgical color of Lent is purple. It is the color of Royalty, which symbolizes the suffering Jesus, and anticipates the glory of resurrection. Jesus was a different type of leader, a servant leader, who suffered for our salvation.

Other things that change during lent include: the Gloria is not sung and the word Alleluia is omitted from the Mass. During this penitential time people offer sacrifices for sins, as prayers for intentions, and to build up their spiritual life.

When I was young, my family always gave up candy. Different people and families have different traditions for Lent. Some attend daily Mass as a family. Others pray the Rosary as a family. Several of our parish families attend the Stations of the Cross at Church or make them privately. I have heard of families taking time to read about the saints or about the Church together.

Lent is a great time to look at your life and see what needs to change. Do you need to pray more? Are there good intentions that you could act upon? Are there sacrifices you should make? Do you need to spend more time with your family and/or God?

### Summer Conferences – Notre Dame Vision, One Bread One Cup, MDI @ Marian

- 1) Notre Dame Vision is canceled this summer.
- 2) St. Meinrad's One Bread, One Cup is planning to have in-person conferences but could go online. One Bread, One Cup focuses more on developing the youth's gifts to serve in the liturgy at Mass like being a Eucharistic minister, cantor, lector, etc. It helps the youth know that they ARE part of the Church and gives them ownership and purpose in the Body of Christ!
- 3) Marian's Missionary Disciples Institute (MDI) plans to have in-person conference but if not will go online. MDI is a smaller,

more immersive experience that prepares high school students to be young missionaries who serve their communities and impact the world through the local church.

We plan to keep the cost at \$100 for each youth (we have scholarship money, donations, and fundraising options to help subsidize). **Please contact Bryan ASAP if interested (deadlines are coming up very soon)** or for information.

### 2021 Summer Mission Trip to Toppa Joppa, TN for HS Youth

Although there are still a lot of unknowns, we are planning to go on a mission trip to Glenmary Home Missioners (aka Toppa Joppa) in Rutledge, TN July 11-16. Types of work have included demolition, drywall, painting, building wheel chair ramps, yard work, replacing floors, roofs & porches. We have reserved 20 spots (must be at least an incoming freshman). We need a few skilled adult chaperones. We are asking for each person to pay \$100 for the trip. We plan to include a day of mountain fun (perhaps whitewater rafting) on the way home!
