



Thank you for all who made the Chicken Dinner a success this year. Together we are able to achieve great things. The food was delicious, the baskets were varied and well put together. Many people visited our Parish and offered many compliments. While we are still tallying the expenses and income, the benefits from this fundraiser will help us in our Parish ministry. A full report of the Chicken Dinner will follow. This fundraiser will make a huge impact on the ministry we are able to provide to our Parish and community.

In complete transparency, I'm going to explain the difference between Fundraising Income versus the Weekly Need you see published in the bulletin each week. The funds raised from the Chicken Dinner, along with all of our other regular fundraisers, are included in our budgeted Fundraising Income. As I am sure you have noticed, we have fallen behind in the Weekly Need shown in the "Stewardship of Treasure" each week. The Weekly Need is a separate budgeted item for our need from Sunday Collections to balance our budget. Additional fundraising income is what will help us make-up the difference in income budgeted weekly. Since we have fallen behind in our weekly budget, additional fundraising efforts (including hopefully having our regular fundraisers raise more funds than expected and adding some additional fundraisers) will be necessary to make up the difference. It is important that all are aware of that. As well, we continue to work to cut expenses. During these challenging financial times, I am sure families are adjusting their budgets as well.


**Renovation Phase 2**
