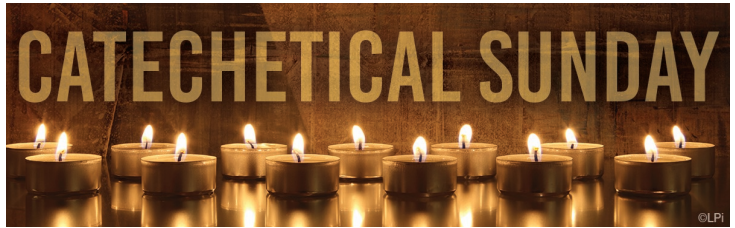
### Pumpkin Sales
