



"A Leap of Father... Sort of" by Deacon Garrett Braun, St. John the Baptist Parish, Fourth Theology

Without even realizing it, my fear about finally deciding to enter seminary was this: "Going to seminary means that I will have no choice but to become a priest." From the outside looking in, it seemed there was an absolute finality about going to seminary. Once I started, there would be no turning back. I began to stress and agonize over this decision that would surely close every other door for the rest of my life. I'm not sure why, but that's how I thought about going to seminary –I get the impression that many young men feel the same way I did.

After a moment of clarity in prayer during a TEC retreat in my junior year of college, I finally realized: going to seminary is not a leap of faith...it's really just one more step on the path which the Lord has been leading me for years. Not only was it the most logical choice, it was the only way I would ever really answer the question – Lord, are you asking me to become a priest or not?

God will make all things clear in his time, but we must do our part as well. Going to seminary did not automatically make me a priest, but the picture of myself serving as a priest gradually came into clearer focus with time. I needed my time at seminary to hear the Lord's voice more clearly and to learn how to surrender to that calling in my life. Going to seminary is not a permanent decision, and though that does not mean it is an easy one, for many men "on the fence" there is far more to be gained than could be lost!
