






As the calendar turns to fall, it is time to think about our annual Chicken Dinner. This year's dinner will be on Sunday, November 3rd.




Next weekend Fr. Joseph Westfall will speak at all of the Masses at both parishes

First Friday Adoration is this Friday, October 4, after the Communion Service. Everyone is encouraged to come and spend an hour with the Lord.


Religious Education for this week is grades preschool – 12 grades.
